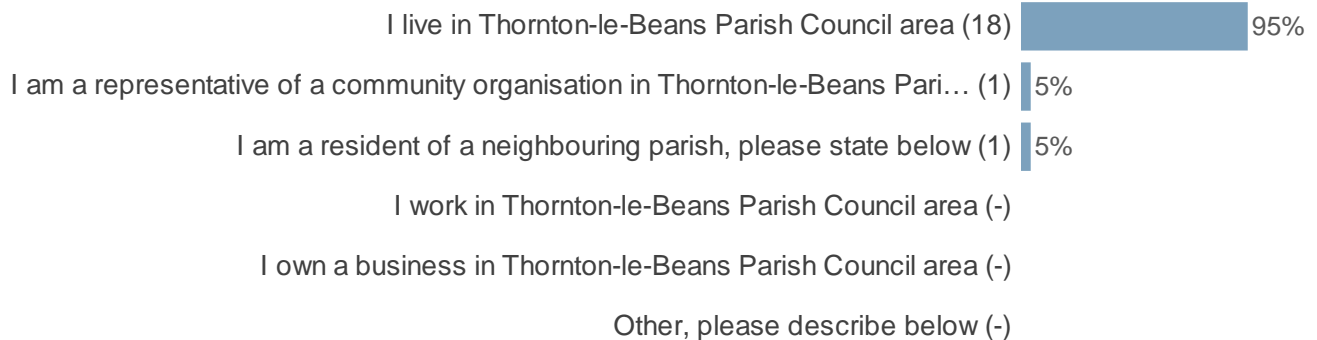


2025-26 CGR - Thornton le Beans

What is your opinion with the following potential solution to rectify the issue at Thornton-le-Beans Parish Council?

Retain the civil parish of Thornton-le-Beans with four councillors, merge the civil parishes of Crosby and Cotcliffe to form a new single civil parish represented by one councillor, with both parishes forming a grouped parish council retaining a council size of five.



Please give reasons for your response:

Common sense

The size of Crosby in terms of voters is negligible, so merging with Cotcliffe provides a more sizeable area represented by the single councillor.

A common sense and practical solution.

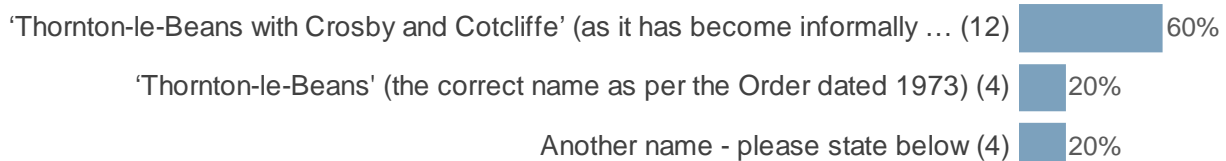
The council has been known this way for over 40 years and I would like it to remain that way
