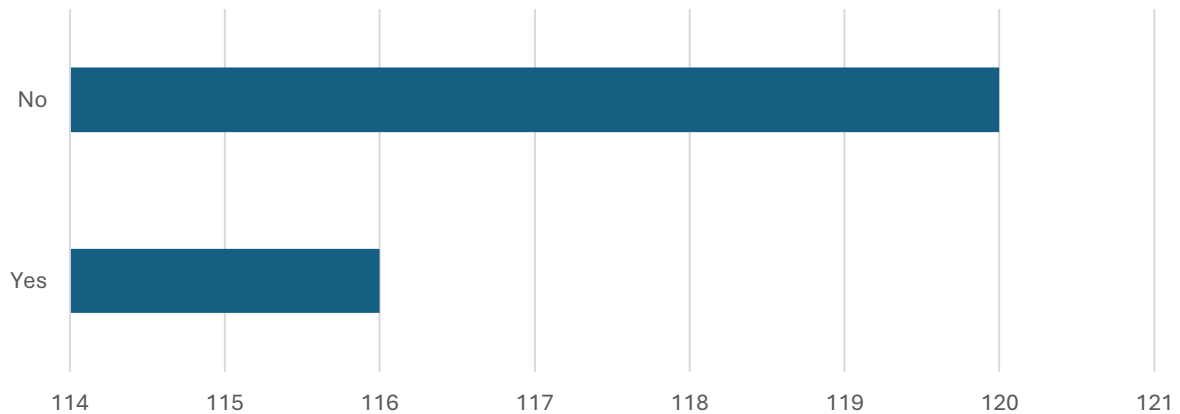
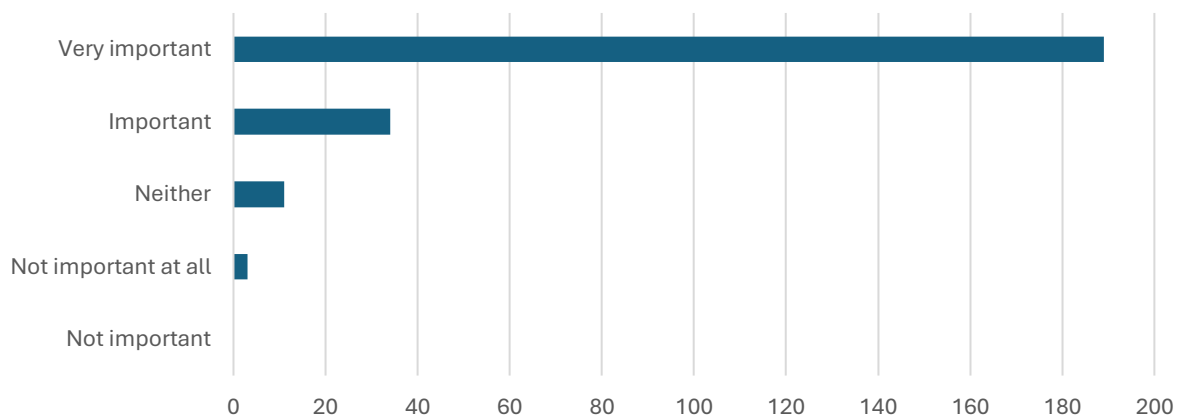


## Inclusive Service Plan and Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Licensing Policy consultation results **EVERYONE ELSE (238 respondents)**

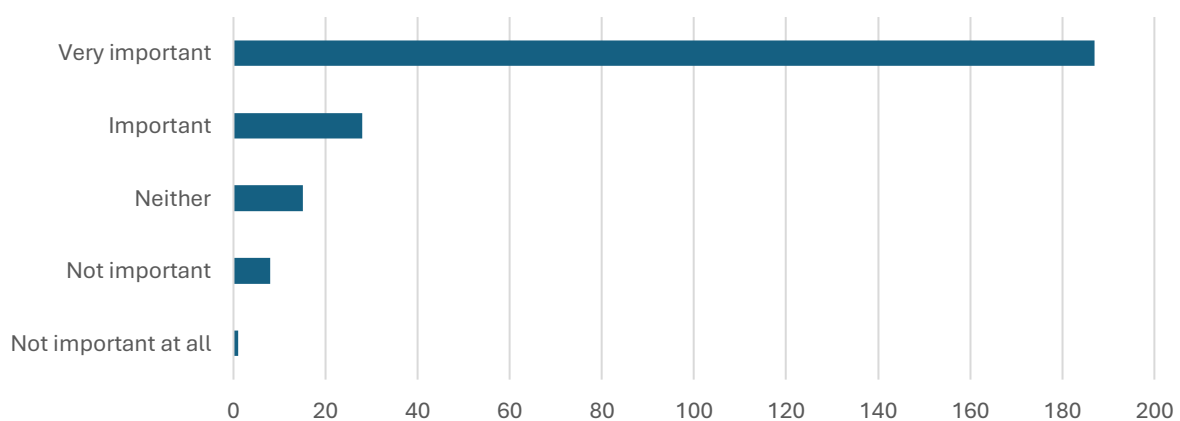
**Q2. Do you have any views on the ISP?**



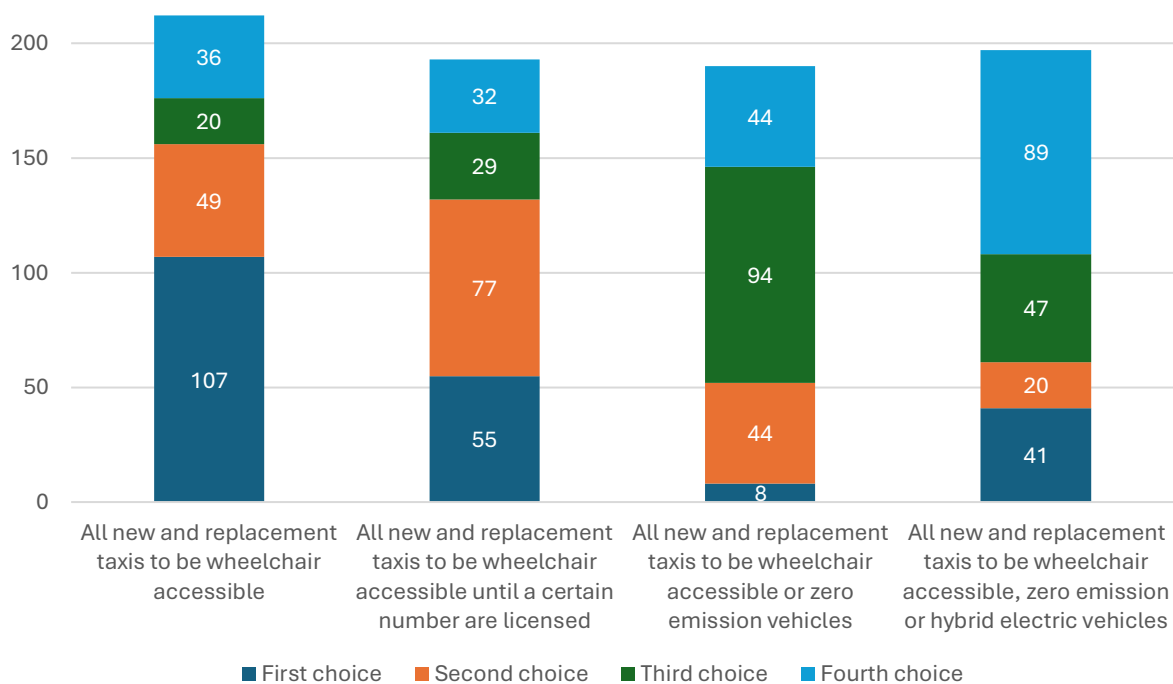
**Q3. How important to you is it that everyone regardless of age, disability, gender, race, religion or sex has equal access to taxis?**

**Q5. To ensure everyone has equal access to a WAV we may consider one of the following options. Please rank your answers in order of preference:**



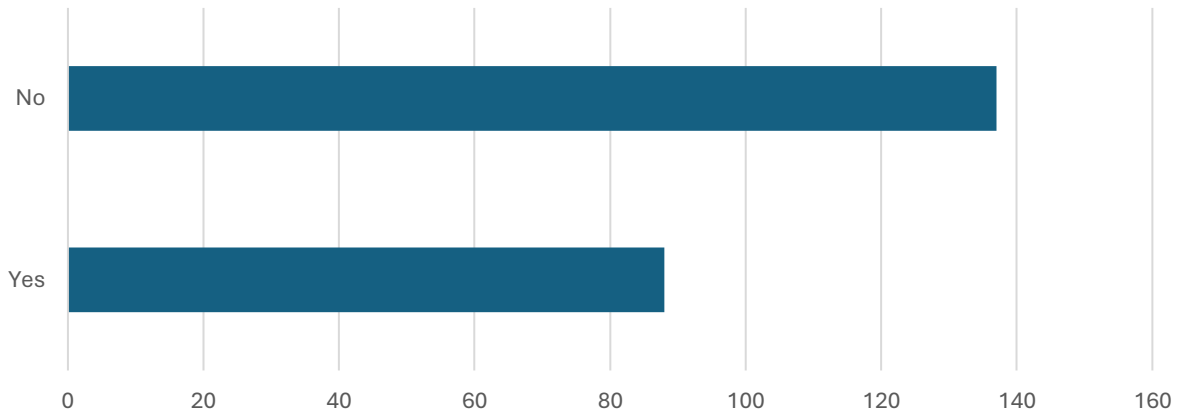
To ensure a fair approach across the four options, a weighting system has been adopted to give more influence to stronger preferences, making the results more representative of what people truly favour.

1st choice = 4 points, 2nd choice = 3 points, 3rd choice = 2 points and 4th choice = 1 point.

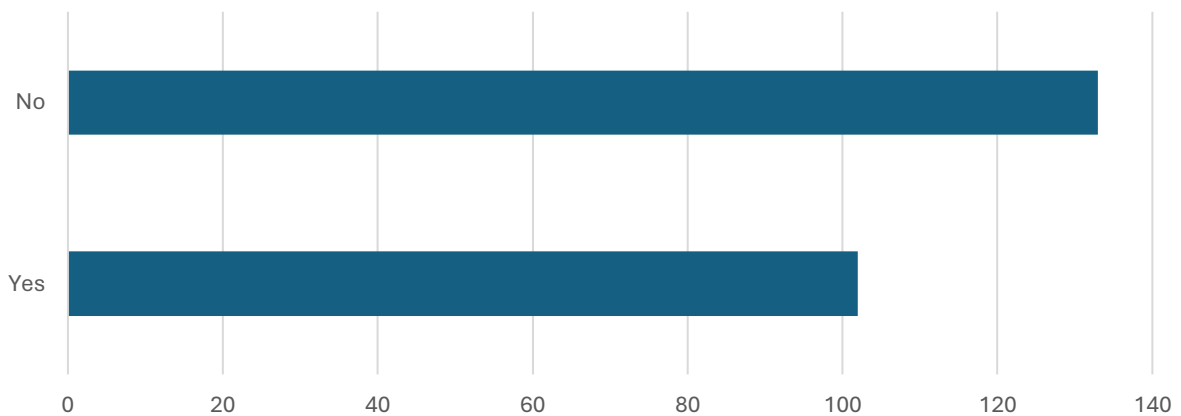
Following the allocation of points, the total has been divided by the number of respondents to the question and an average point score provided, as follows...

Policy option	Total points	Average points per response
<b>All new and replacement taxis to be wheelchair accessible</b>	<b>651</b>	<b>3.07</b>
All new and replacement taxis to be wheelchair accessible until a certain number are licensed	541	2.80
All new and replacement taxis to be wheelchair accessible or zero emission vehicles	396	2.08
All new and replacement taxis to be wheelchair accessible, zero emission or hybrid electric vehicles	407	2.07

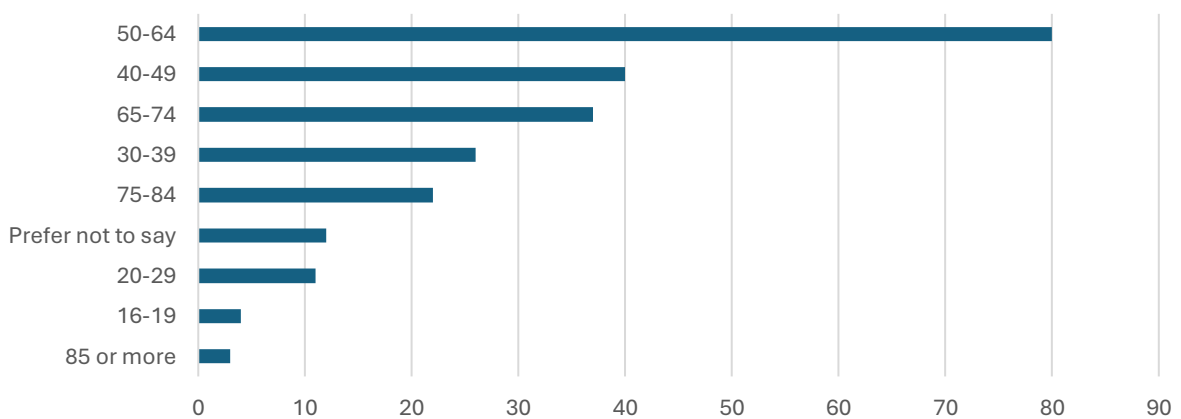
**Q6. Do you have any specific views on the four options listed above or any suggestions for other options the council could consider to ensure there is adequate provision of WAVs?**



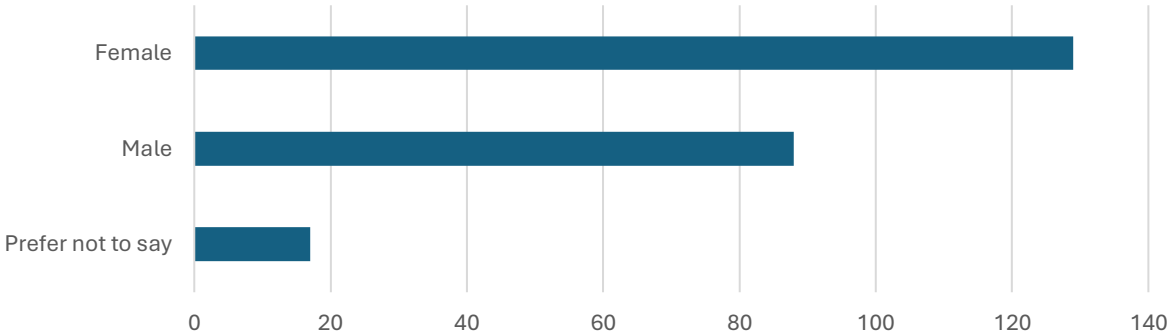
**Q7. Do you have any views on whether or not we should also introduce similar options as outlined above on private hire vehicles?**
